Concept for the emergency operation of research at the Faculty of Science

Work in university buildings is possible to a reduced extent, as far as this is safely possible. Aim: Prevent infection.

- Access to the buildings is limited to authorized staff with a key.
- All meetings and courses are held via video conference, including one-to-one meetings.
- Wherever possible, work is done at home in the home office.
- Experimental work should be kept to a minimum.
- Only one person per room (laboratory or office) may work at any one time. Exceptions only in justified and approved cases.
- Shared equipment and other shared items must be disinfected before and after use.
- Elevators and social areas should only be used alone at most. The use of public areas must be minimized.
- Compliance with the rules will be checked regularly.
- Care of infrastructures, animal stations, facilities and services is regulated in detail, especially also in view of a complete shutdown of the university.

Furthermore:

- Wash your hands regularly. Do not touch the face.
- Avoid public transport.
- If you have a fever or cough, stay at home.
- If a member of the household is ill or a corona virus infection is suspected, stay at home.
- Members of risk groups stay at home.
