Information sheet: PLAGIARISM

What is plagiarism?

- → Intellectual property theft
- → Wrongful appropriation of someone else's written, artistic, scientific or other work, thoughts or ideas and their publication
- → Also: work that is the product of plagiarism

Procedure for discovering plagiarism:

Lecturers are asked to report clear cases of plagiarism to the Dean's Office/Office of the Dean of Studies. Depending on the severity of the case, the Dean's Office will send an email or a letter outlining the charges and consequences.

What are the consequences of verifiable cases of plagiarism?

Plagiarism cases are treated as follows:

Lecture, course with examination: fail or Grade 1

Written works:

- Grade 1
- The work cannot be repeated as part of the same seminar; the student concerned must attend another seminar (this must be checked individually)
- In the event of recurrence: exmatriculation for one or more semesters

Bachelor's or master's thesis:

- Grade 1 after the first attempt
- In the event of recurrence: grade 1 and exclusion from the program of study
