



Withdrawal of doctoral training

The withdrawal of the doctoral agreement and of any third-party financed employment relationship associated with the doctoral relationship is possible at any time upon mutual agreement.

In the event of a conflict, both parties can request mediation by the Doctoral Board.

In the case of discrepancies, the below process should be followed:

- 1) A meeting should be arranged between the Doctoral Committee and the doctoral student
- 2) If it is agreed that the doctoral relationship will be terminated, this should be documented with a brief justification in the minutes
- 3) The minutes must be signed by all parties
- 4) The original of the signed minutes must be submitted to the Dean's Office immediately by the Group I member of the Doctoral Committee
- 5) The Dean's Office will then inform the Student Administration Office of the termination of the doctoral relationship. Without a new supervision agreement, the doctoral student cannot register for the following semester

The procedure documented here should not be classified as an unsuccessful attempt at a doctorate.
